



2016-17 Ski/Snowboarding Club Information



The Wendover Middle School Ski/Snowboarding Club is organizing another year of skiing and snowboarding. The following information is to help answer any questions you or your child may have.

MEMBERSHIP

Open to any 6th, 7th, or 8th grade student who agrees to comply with ski club and resort policies. Membership dues are \$20. Each member will have his/her bus fee paid on the first trip they attend.

TRIPS

Trips will be scheduled on Thursday or Friday night and are dependent upon weather, snow conditions, and fulfillment of the group quota (20 lift tickets). The bus will leave Wendover MS at approx. 2:45 PM, and return to Wendover MS at approx. 10:15 PM. Please do not be late when picking up your child!

Trips will be announced at the beginning of each week, and paid for when the student signs up (cash or check payable to Wendover MS). Sign-ups take place in Room 131 (Math Lab) during homeroom.

Friends and family are able to meet us at 7Springs and take advantage of discounted lift tickets, rentals, and lessons (must be picked up at group sales desk or make arrangements for your child to take the extras).

In the event of inclement weather or extreme cold temperatures, trips may be cancelled. Announcements will be made in school when this occurs.

LESSONS

All skiers and snowboarders must take at least three lessons unless you are already an experienced skier or boarder. In order to reduce accidents and promote safety, the club encourages all members to take lessons.

SKI CLUB SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR POLICIES

Ski Club Rules

1. Abide by ski resort's policies. A copy of Seven Springs responsibility code follows.
2. **Always** ski or snowboard with a partner. If you need a partner, inform one of the ski club sponsors.
3. Be at the bus 5 minutes before departure time. Any student who is late to the bus will be restricted from the next trip.
4. Stay in designated areas for skiing and eating.
5. Students may eat on the bus. This is a privilege which can be taken away if garbage is left on the bus.
6. Show appropriate behavior at all times! Be respectful and use good manners. Remember: you represent the sponsors and your school.
7. Students may not attend ski trips if they are academically ineligible. The student must be passing at least four full-time subjects or the equivalent. Students must maintain passing criteria and eligibility shall be cumulative from the beginning of a grading period and reported on a weekly basis. Students may also not attend if they are placed on restriction from school activities by a principal for behavior or academic reasons.

Responsibility Code (from Seven Springs)

1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must NOT stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and stay out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.
